The Charité is the largest university hospital in Germany. Medical care, research, and teaching delivered on its premises is of the highest international standard.

★ Features of this program are:

- Language course (14 months) at the Charité campus in Berlin in classes with fellow doctors from KSA (knowledge of the German language is not required before the arrival in Berlin)
- Five to six years fully-integrated further training according to the curriculum of the Berlin Chamber of Physicians leading to the Medical Specialist Certificate (in German: Facharzt) after passing the Board exam.
- Full member of the medical team
- Regular review of training progress for each individual participant by the Medical Directorate of the Charité (Program Manager)
- Equal salary (compared with German doctors) including social security contributions and benefits
- Assistance with all administrative procedures (visa, work and residence permit), accommodation, nursery, etc.



Requirements:

- Citizenship of the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia
- Graduation at a university in the KSA or another university abroad with excellent results
- Scholarship from the Ministry of Education or University

1 *Check the Cultural Missions Website!*

2 *Apply!*

Applications are either through the cultural mission's website (Currently only Charité is available) or directly to universities that are approved by the Ministry of Education <https://ru.moe.gov.sa/Search>.

There is no "matching" system as seen in KSA, so there is no application deadline. Applicants will get accepted based on the vacancy of the hospital.

3 *Sponsor?*

If you are not sponsored by the MoR, apply to Hospitals/Universities for a sponsorship.

Three types of sponsors:

- a- University sponsors
- b- Hospital/medical city sponsors
- c- The Custodian of the Two Holy Mosques Scholarship Program

- Contact them and know their rules and requirements and apply as early as possible.

4 *Accepted? Learn the Language*

You will need B2 level in general German (Goethe or Telc) and C1 level in Medical German (Fachsprache) in most universities/hospitals.

5 *Getting the Medical License*

The Medical License Approbation, which will be divided into 3 Parts:

- Testing clinical skills by taking history and writing a medical report..
- Then, the examiners will ask the examinee for spot diagnosis and to do certain clinical examinations.
- Then, testing the medical knowledge (Kenntnisprüfung) - interdisciplinary questions on ER, pharmacology, radiology.. Etc.

*Each doctor has 3 chances only to pass!
